Role Title: Camp EPIC Service Crew Member

Location: River Dart Country Park, Devon

Age: 14+ (young adults and adults)

Reports to: Service Crew Lead / Camp Operations Team

Time Commitment: Full weekend (including early arrival for setup)



Purpose of the Role

To help create a smooth, safe and exciting camp environment for all attendees by assisting with logistics, camp support and event atmosphere. Service Crew members play a vital role in keeping the event running, supporting leaders, welcoming participants, and helping to deliver an EPIC experience for everyone.

Key Responsibilities

Service Crew members will be allocated duties across the weekend, which may include:

<p> Welcoming & Supporting Participants</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Greeting Rainbows, Brownies, Guides, Rangers, Leaders and volunteers on arrival• Helping with arrivals and departures• Directing unit drop-off and parking (non-traffic management level)• Providing information and answering questions	<p> Camp Logistics</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Helping to pitch or strike tents on the main camp• Assisting with the set-up and pack-down of activity bases and common areas• Supporting the upkeep of shared spaces (tidying, litter checks, replenishing supplies)
<p> Event Support</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Assisting during mealtimes and at key transition points• Supporting Opening and Closing ceremonies• Helping with evening entertainment logistics (lighting, seating, setup, pack-down)• Helping with communication and message delivery around camp (runner duties)	<p> Atmosphere & Engagement</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Being a visible, friendly, fun presence across camp• Helping build excitement, boost morale and encourage participation• Optional: wearing EPIC-themed clothing or accessories to add fun to the atmosphere
